Call for Entry – Contest Closes September 30th, 2018

Writers of short stories and poetry are encouraged to submit their works to the 24th Annual Power of the Pen Awards. Entrants must be between the ages of 12 and 18 and be a resident of Hamilton or attend a school in Hamilton. Please submit an original short story or poem before September 30, 2018 to be eligible. A distinguished panel of professional writers and reviewers will judge the entries on the basis of originality, style, general presentation as well as spelling and grammar.

Online submissions are encouraged – hpl.ca/teens.

Categories

Participants can enter both the English and French categories.

English

Please submit one poem and/or short story per person to our English category. Each entry will be submitted in the age group that you fall in (12 poetry, 12 short story, 13 poetry, etc.)

French

Please submit one poem and/or nouvelle to our French Category. The number of categories will depend on the number of entries received.

Prizes:

A first and second prize winner will be chosen in each age category – 12 through 18 years of age. First prize winners in each age category will receive a cash prize of \$100 while second prize winners in each age category will receive \$25. Award winners will receive a copy of the Power of the Pen publication.

Each English-prize-winning entry will also qualify for the Hamilton Association for the Advancement of Literature, Science and Art's prestigious Maitland Banting Silver Quill Award and the Hamilton Association Young Poet's Award. The winner in each category will receive a cash prize of \$250.

Contest Rules:

- Entrants must be between the ages of 12 and 18 and be a resident of Hamilton or a neighbouring city.
- One poem and/or short story per person may be submitted in both the English and French categories.
 Each entry requires a separate entry form.
- Short stories must not exceed 2,500 words in length. Poems may be any length.
- Entries should be typed, double-spaced and all pages numbered. Paper copies are required for mailed and hand-delivered submissions.
- Typed entries must double-spaced, with font Arial or Times New Roman and size 11 or 12 point.
- Do not put your name anywhere on your work. Your name must be on the entry form only.
- All works submitted must be original. If it is fanfiction, the work of inspiration must be clearly named.
- The decision of the judges is final.
- Judged submissions will be available for pick-up the evening of the awards ceremony or during the month
 of January at Central Library.
- All entries will be scanned to ensure originality. Plagiarism will result in automatic disqualification.

How to Enter:

Attach an entry form to your submission. Submit your original short story and or poem to any branch of the Hamilton Public Library by **September 30, 2018.** Winners will be notified in December and will be asked to provide an electronic copy of their winning submission for publication and posting.
