Celebrate Canada by making and playing a Canada Bingo game.

## Make A Bingo Game

Build a Bingo game. Using the template attached (or draw one if you like) come up with some ideas for a Bingo game with a Canadian twist. You can either draw the ideas onto the board or cut and paste images from magazines and newspapers.

#### **Suggested Materials:**

- Pencil
- Crayons/markers
- Paper
- Bingo template (see attached, if you can't print one you can also draw one like the template provided)

#### Now it's time to brainstorm

What do you think of when you think about Canada?

Here are some ideas to get you started:

- Hockey
- Maple Syrup
- Maple Leaf
- Loonie coins

You will probably want to list at least 30 items that make you think of Canada.

Add them to your Bingo templates, either by drawing or cutting out pictures from magazines and newspapers and attaching them. Mix up the pictures to make sure everyone playing does not have the same board.

Next, you will want to find items in your house to use as markers. You can use pennies or LEGO pieces or bits of paper.





Ask a grown-up to write on paper all your ideas. Cut each one, put them in a jar or a hat and pull out one at a time. When they call out the word, the players cover that spot on their Bingo card. Try to get five in a row and be the first to yell out Bingo.
