Practice counting down and celebrate New Year's Eve at any time of day with these activities.

This week's activities: Party Hat - Noisemaker

# **Party Hat**

## **Suggested Materials:**

- Construction paper (or any kind of paper)
- Scissors
- Crayons or markers
- Tape (or glue)
- String and hole punch (optional)

### **Directions:**

- 1. Cut paper into a circle (about 9 cm across). You can use a paper plate to help you trace a perfect circle.
- 2. Cut a slim triangle on one side of the circle (make sure it's narrower at the centre of your circle)
- 3. Slide one side of the cut out over the other to make a cone.
- 4. Tape along the seam.
- 5. If you want to add a tie, punch two holes one on either side of the hat and tie string to it so it can stay securely on your head.
- 6. Decorate your hat with markers, crayons, glitter anything you want!

# **Noisemaker Tambourine**

# **Suggested Materials:**

- Paper plates (2)
- Beads (or something else that rattles)
- Tape or glue
- Crayons or markers

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Decorate the bottom of your 2 plates (the side that would sit on the table).
- 2. Lay one plate face up and sprinkle in some beads.






- 3. Place the other paper plate on top and tape the plates together (or hole punch around the rim and tie together using ribbon).
- 4. Make some noise!
