



SNOWMAN BUILDING

You can build a snowman without snow. Try building some inside with these activities.

This week's activities: "Snowy" Snowman - Snowman Shapes

"Snowy" Snowman

Suggested Materials:

- 2 cups cornstarch
- 1 cup conditioner (or lotion)
- Bowl

Directions:

- 1. Stir cornstarch and conditioner together. If it's too sticky, stir in more cornstarch. If too dry, add more conditioner.
- 2. Once you get the right consistency (a bit on the dry side), you should be able to roll the mixture into balls and build a 'snowman.'

Snowman Shapes

Suggested Materials:

- LEGO blocks
- Blocks
- Dominos

Directions:

Build a snowman out of items you have inside your home.

Maybe you need to build your snowman lying down. How tall can you build your snowman? How wide?
