You can build a snowman without snow. Try building some inside with these activities.

This week's activities: "Snowy" Snowman – Snowman Shapes

"Snowy" Snowman

Suggested Materials:

- 2 cups of cornstarch
- 1 cup of conditioner (or lotion)
- Bowl

Directions:

1. Stir cornstarch and conditioner together. If it's too sticky, stir in more cornstarch. If too dry, add more conditioner.
2. Once you get the right consistency (a bit on the dry side), you should be able to roll the mixture into balls and build a 'snowman.'

- LEGO blocks
- Blocks
- Dominos

Directions:

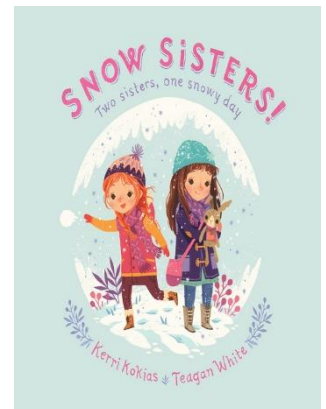
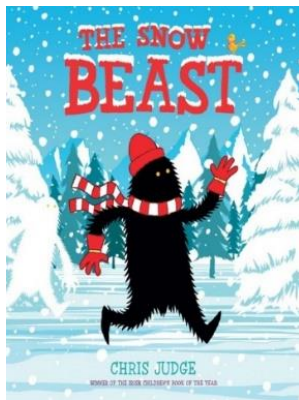
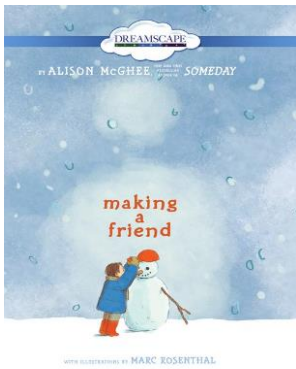
Build a snowman using items you have inside your home.
