**This week's activities: ABC Object Hunt – ABC Letter Hunt**

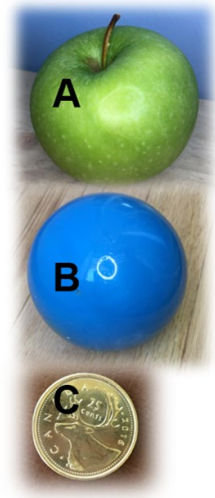
### ABC Object Hunt

#### Suggested Materials:

- Everything in your home
- Scavenger Hunt worksheet (if you can't print the one at the bottom, you can make your own list on blank paper)

#### Directions:

Search your home to find an object that starts with each letter of the alphabet. First, find something that start with the letter A. Did you find an apple? An alarm clock? A toy alligator? The options are endless but it's certainly an amusiang adventure! Add your A item to the Alphabet Scavenger Hunt worksheet. Now it's time for B! Keep going until you've found 26 items and filled out on your whole Alphabet Scavenger Hunt Worksheet!



#### Take it outside!

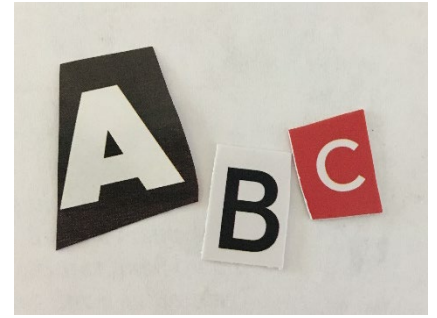

- Old magazine, flyers, or newspaper



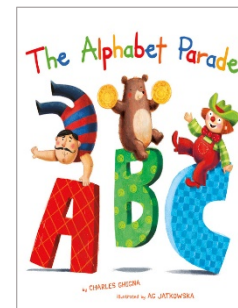
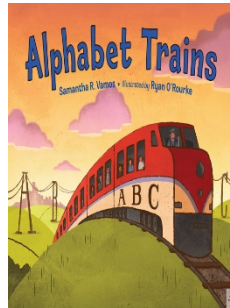
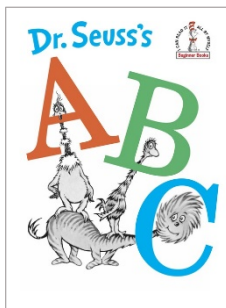
## Directions:

You can find letters all around you. Go on a scavenger hunt to see if you can find them all. Inside the house they may find letters on book covers, toy packages, trading cards, board games, food packaging, and so much more. Outside, look for letters on street signs, store signs, or license plates.

Create your own alphabet using the template or a plain piece of paper. Hunt through old magazines, flyers, or newspapers to find each letter of the alphabet. Cut them out and paste them onto your paper. Bonus points if you can find a capital and a lower case!
