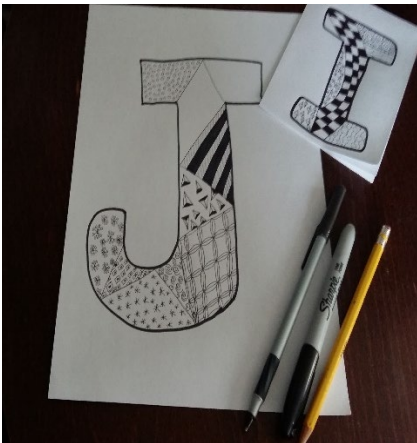


MONOGRAM ZENTANGLE

Monogram Zentangle

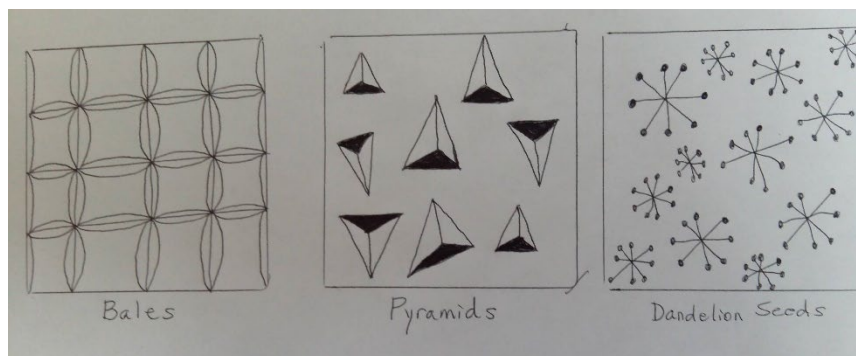
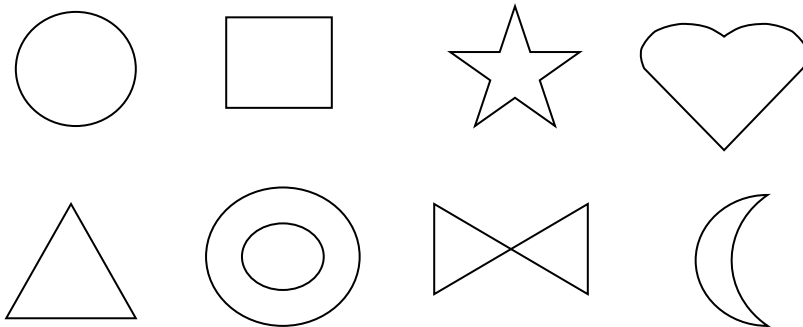


Suggested Materials:

- Black pen or fine tip marker
- Pencil
- Paper

Directions:

1. Look at ideas for letters, patterns, and repeating shapes. Check out the eResources below for more inspiration.
2. With a pencil, draw an outline of a letter of the alphabet that fills most of your page. When you are happy with the shape of your letter, you can darken the outline of the letter with black marker or pen.
3. Next, divide your letter into sections.
4. Choose a section and fill it with a pattern of your choice using a black marker or pen. Here are some examples, and you can look at the eResources below for more ideas.
5. Continue filling sections with different patterns until you have done them all.
6. Frame your masterpiece.
