



PAPER MOSAIC ART

Mosaics are pictures or designs made up of small pieces of stone, glass, tile, or shell. In our case, we are making mosaics out of paper. Display your creativity by creating mosaic art at home.

Make a Mosaic

Suggested Materials:

- Paper
- Coloured paper (construction paper works well)
- Glue
- Scissors
- Optional: crayons or markers, stickers for decorating

Directions:

1. Draw a shape you want to use to fill in (ex. a fish or butterfly) or start with a blank canvas.
2. Cut the colours you want to use into small pieces using different shapes and sizes.
3. Glue pieces onto paper to create a mosaic.
4. Display your masterpiece.

Challenge Yourself

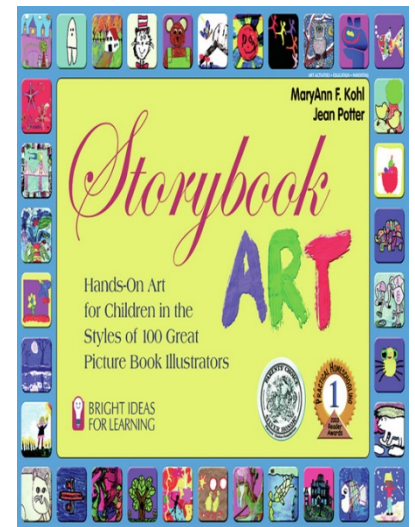
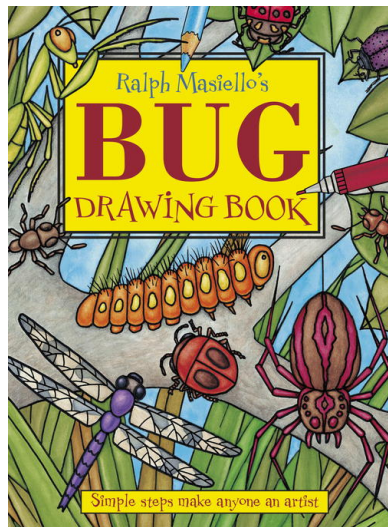
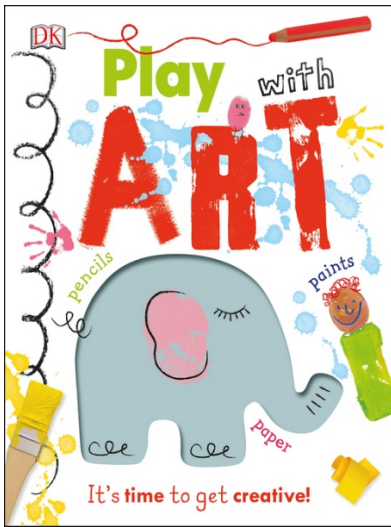
