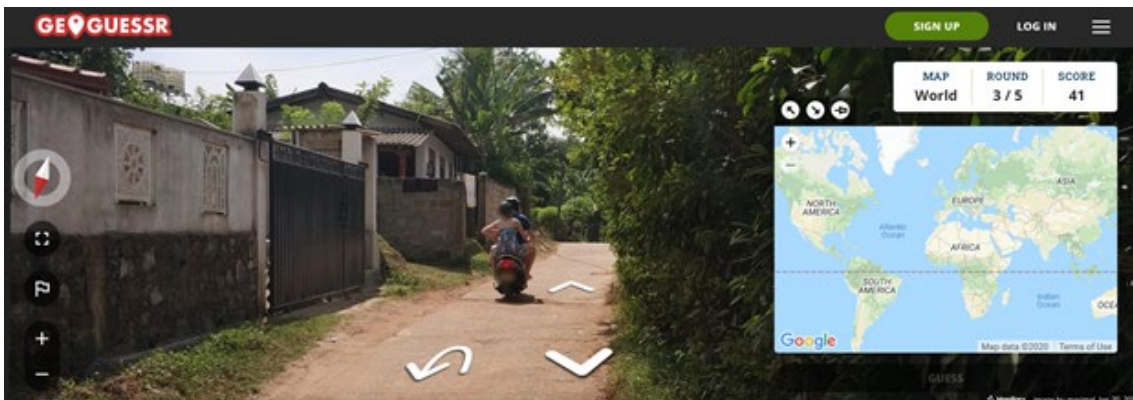
Suggested Materials:

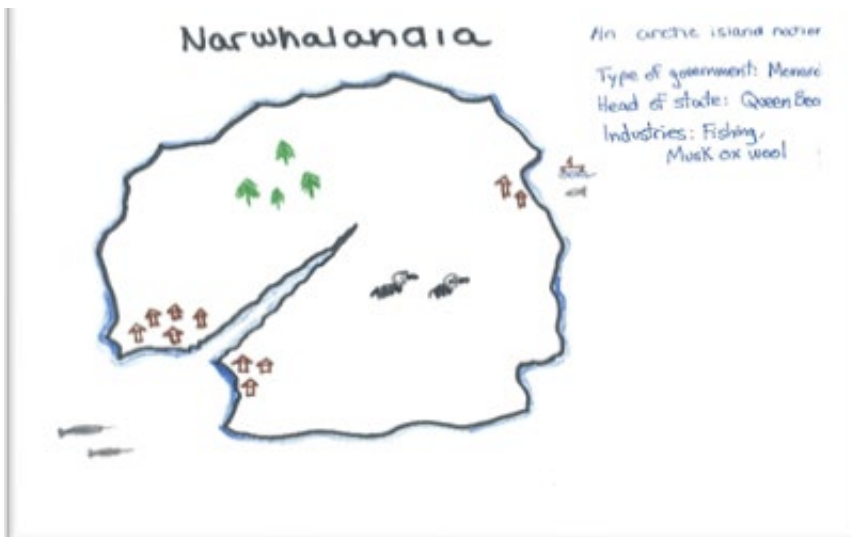
Suggested Materials:
