Bring the fall fair fun home with these games and crafts.

This week's activities: Bean Bag Toss – Pin the Face on the Pumpkin – Scarecrow Puppet

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Bean Bag Toss

Suggested Materials:

- 5 buckets labelled 10, 20, 30 40, 50
- 5 bean bags or small balls

Directions:

- 1. Line the buckets up one behind the other in numerical order.
- 2. Stand a foot away from the first bucket and toss each bean bag.
- 3. The higher the number on the bucket, the higher the score you get. The highest score wins!

Pin the Face on the Pumpkin

Suggested Materials:

- Construction paper (black and orange if you have it)
- Tape
- Blindfold (or you can close your eyes)

Directions:

- 1. Cut orange paper in a pumpkin shape. Cut two triangles using the black construction paper. Tape or glue the eyes onto your pumpkin.
- 2. Using the black construction paper, cut out a mouth. Make pointy teeth, or square teeth.
- 3. Attach the pumpkin shapes to the wall.
- 4. Fold some tape with the sticky side out and stick it to the back of the mouth.





5. Stand a few feet away from your pumpkin. While blindfolded try to press the pieces in the correct spots to make a face.

Scarecrow Puppet

Suggested Materials:

- Paper bag
- Construction paper
- Crayons
- Tape or glue
- Scissors

Directions

- 1. Cut out a hat, hair, and a face. If you only have a paper bag, you can colour these.
- 2. Glue the scarecrow's features onto the paper bag. Use the flap of the paper bag as the mouth.
