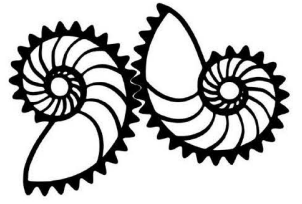

Hess might have in his medical bag:

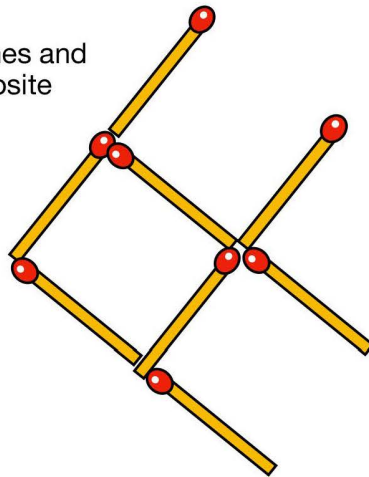

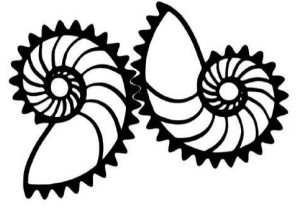

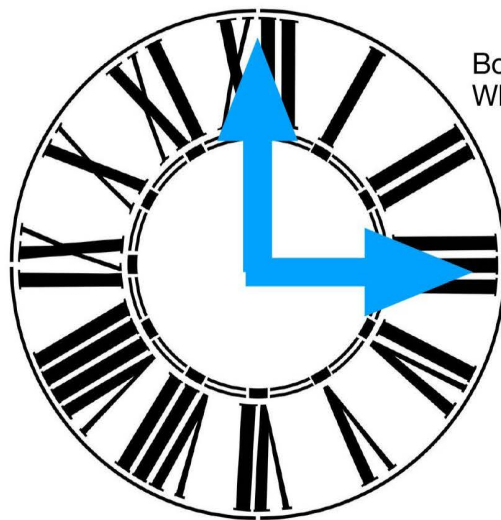
Puzzle #2

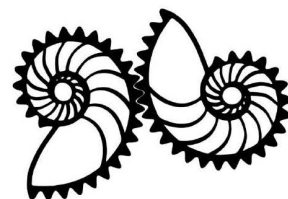

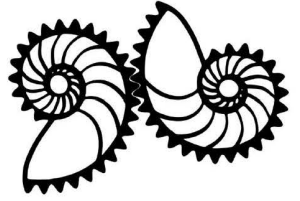

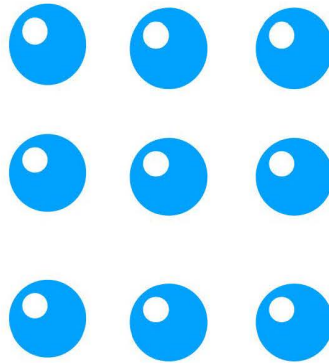
