



PAPER MOSAIC ART

Mosaics are pictures or designs made up of small pieces of stone, glass, tile or shells. Here, we show you how to make mosaics with paper.

Make a Mosaic

Suggested Materials:

- Paper
- Coloured paper (construction paper works well.)
- Glue
- Scissors
- Optional: crayons or markers, stickers for decorating

Directions:

1. Draw a shape, such as a fish or butterfly, or start with a blank canvas.
2. Cut the colours you want to use into small pieces, using various shapes and sizes.
3. Glue pieces onto paper to create a mosaic.
4. Show off your masterpiece.

Challenge Yourself

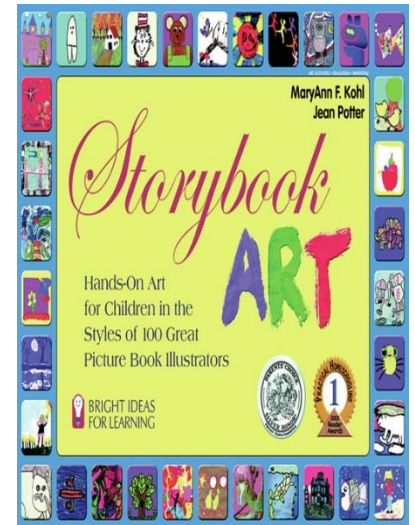
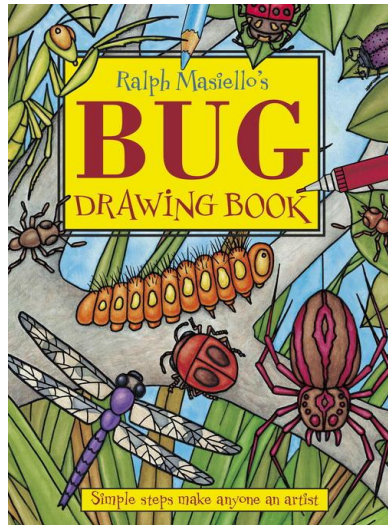
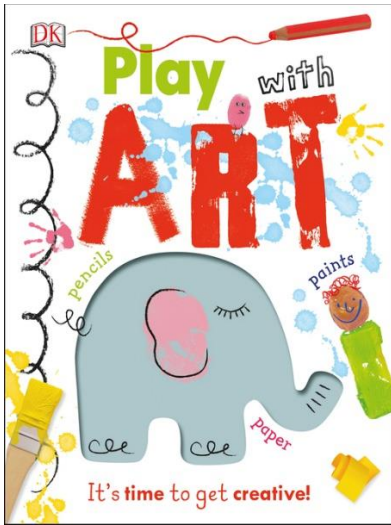
