


## Other Devices:

1. Log on to Open Library using [the login page](#).
2. Search for a book or select one from the home page.
3. Once you've found a book you want to read, click "Borrow" and the book will automatically be checked out to your account. Borrowing rules change per book and publication, some may have longer loan periods, and some may have a wait list.








