



Create an Account:

1. Navigate to the Open Library home page. www.openlibrary.org.
2. Select "Sign Up" in the upper right corner.



3. Enter the required information on the sign-up page and complete the CAPTCHA. Open Library requires that you agree to their terms and conditions before signing up for an account. You may read these terms and conditions by clicking "Terms of Use".




4. Web viewer opens. To download ePub, tap on the menu icon - loan information - 'Encrypted Adobe ePub'


1. From the App Store, Download Aldiko Book Reader




2. Open Aldiko Book Reader, open "Settings" and select "DRM Account". Select Adobe ID and enter in your Adobe ID info.






3. Find an available eBook and tap on Borrow This Book



4. Scroll down to "Download Options. Select 'Encrypted Adobe ePub' to download the ebook.




5. Once the download is complete, tap "open in" and select "Open in..." and choose "Aldiko Book Reader".

3. Once you've found a book you want to read, click "Borrow" and the book will automatically be checked out to your account. Borrowing rules change per book and publication, some may have longer loan periods, and some may have a wait list.




