



## Yamaha DTX502 Electronic Drum Kit

1. Plug the drum kit control module, located on the left of the kit, into a standard power outlet. All drum modules should already be connected as they need to be.
2. Turn the drum kit on using the power button, which is located on the top right corner of the control module.
3. The headphone jack is on the front edge of the control module, near the left corner. Please note that this is a 1/4" (6.35mm) socket, so most headphones will require the use of a 3.5mm-to-1/4" adapter. The Makerspace has one that can be borrowed.
4. The outputs for recording are on the back of the control module, next to the drum module inputs, at the left of the rear. These can be plugged into the M-Track audio interface using 1/4" instrument cables. Recording can be done in mono, using just the left output (either channel of the M-Track can be used for the input), or in stereo, using both outputs and both M-Track inputs. For a stereo recording setup, connect the Left output to input 1 on the M-Track, and the Right output to input 2 on the M-Track.
5. The wheel on the front of the control module can be used to select the set of drum sounds you wish to use. The output volume can be adjusted with the volume buttons, also on the front of the control module.
